

Transition Planning Checklist

The transition to college includes many steps, including the planning of your academic accommodations. Use this checklist to help yourself stay organized as you plan for your academic accommodations and services at Fleming.

Learn about your program and College

- I have met with my high school disability contact (e.g., guidance counsellor, Special Education Resource Teacher) to discuss my transition to post-secondary education
- I have visited the campus where I will be attending
- I know where the Counselling Service department is located and who I should contact
- I know where the Accessible Education Service department is located and who I should contact

Collect your documentation

- I have a copy of my high school transcript or record of upgrading
- I have a copy of my most recent IEP/IPRC
- I have a copy of my most recent psycho-educational assessment
- I have a copy of a letter from my health care professional

Register with Accessible Education Services

- I have made contact with Accessible Education Services at Fleming College

Prepare for your Accommodation meeting

- I have prepared a list of questions that I would like answered about my academic accommodations
- I have a good understanding of my learning style and accommodation needs and can talk about them with my counsellor
- I am aware of the bursaries, grants, loans and scholarships for which I qualify
