

COURSE OUTLINE USER FEEDBACK SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT - FALL 2014

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Background

In November 2014, Fleming Data Research (FDR) was contacted by David Baker, Business Analyst, Academic Operations, to assist in the administration of a survey to obtain faculty feedback about the Course Outline system.

Methodology

Nature of Sample

The population for this survey included more than 300 faculty members at Fleming College in the Fall of 2014.

A web-based survey was designed by FDR in collaboration with David Baker. An email containing a link to the web-based survey was sent to faculty on November 17th, 2014.

Sample Size and Limitations

Survey responses were processed on December 2nd, 2014. A total of 43 responses were received. Any blank or identifiable duplicate responses were removed for a total of 37 responses. The following is a summary of responses by question for those 37 responses.

Due to rounding of percentages, the total percentage of responses for some questions may be slightly higher or lower than 100%.
