Bachelor of Recreation and Leisure Studies Degree**

This document will serve as the official articulation agreement for a joint Degree/Diploma Program between the Sir Sandford Fleming College Recreation and Leisure Services Program and the Brock University Recreation and Leisure Studies Program.

In order to obtain both a degree and a diploma in Recreation, the student would complete:

- 1a) Two (2) years at Sir Sandford Fleming College in the Recreation and Leisure Services Program plus seven and half (7.5) credits at Brock University for a three (3) year fifteen (15) credit pass degree.
- 1b) Two (2) years at Sir Sandford Fleming College in the Recreation and Leisure Services Program plus twelve and a half (12.5) credits at Brock University for a four (4) year twenty (20) credit Honours degree.

OR

- 1 Three (3) years (15 credit pass degree) at Brock University plus one (1) year at Sir Sandford Fleming College in the Recreation and Leisure Services Program

It is understood that the following conditions will apply for acceptance of a Recreation and Leisure Services diploma program graduate applying to the Brock University Recreation and Leisure Studies degree program:


- 1 The Sir Sandford Fleming College Recreation and Leisure Services Program graduate must have a minimum overall 75% grade average from the Recreation and Leisure Services Program.
- 2 The Recreation and Leisure Services Program graduate will be given up to seven and a half (7.5) credits towards the BRLS fifteen (15) credit pass degree or towards the twenty (20) credits honours degree as determined by the Registrar's Office at Brock University in consultation with the Brock Recreation and Leisure Studies Department.
- 3 The Recreation and Leisure Services Program graduate would require at least seven and a half (7.5) additional Brock University credits to obtain the BRLS fifteen (15) credit pass degree.
- 4 The Recreation and Leisure Services Program graduate would require at least twelve and a half (12.5) additional Brock University credits to obtain the BRLS twenty (20) credit honours degree.

- 5 The specific courses required would be determined in consultation with the Program Advisor of the Recreation and Leisure Studies Program at Brock University.

It is understood that the following conditions will apply for acceptance of a Brock University Recreation and Leisure Studies degree program graduate applying to the Sir Sandford Fleming College Recreation and Leisure Services diploma program:


1. The Brock University graduate with a Recreation and Leisure Studies fifteen (15) credit pass degree must have a minimum overall grade average of 65%.
2. The Brock University graduate would require two (2) semesters in full-time attendance at Sir Sandford Fleming College to obtain the Recreation and Leisure Services Diploma.
3. The specific courses required would be determined by the co-ordinator of the Recreation and Leisure Services Program at Sir Sandford Fleming College.




