This agreement establishes the principles, guidelines and procedures governing admission and assessment of selected qualified students to enter the Bachelor of Arts, Honours degree in Psychology at Trent University on an advanced standing basis, subsequent to the successful completion of Fleming College's Early Childhood Education four-semester diploma.

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1. The purpose of this agreement is to provide qualified graduates of Fleming College's four semester Early Childhood Education Diploma with a seamless option for continuing their education at Trent University in the Bachelor of Arts, Honours degree in Psychology.

2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

2.1. Program Collaboration

- Program faculty and their departments will be responsible for coordinating collaborative meetings to engage in ongoing discussions to enhance and coordinate their programs.
- Trent's program faculty will support incoming students by providing them with relevant information related to their program.

2.2. Student Supports

Trent's program faculty will provide additional supports as required and agreed upon in the signed memorandum between the institutions.

2.3. Admissions

The Admissions Office at Trent University will be responsible for ensuring that eligible students will be awarded credit transfers as stated in said agreement.

2.4. Recruitment and Marketing

Recruitment and Marketing representatives at both institutions will be responsible for promoting the articulation pathway, recruiting students and providing the necessary orientation as students move from one institution to the other.

2.5. Students

Through communication with program faculty and orientation sessions, students will be advised to consult academic advisors to ensure they are successfully completing program requirements.

3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT

- 3.1. Graduates of the four semester Early Childhood Education Diploma from Fleming College will be granted 5.0 credits towards a Bachelor of Arts, Honours degree in Psychology at Trent University.
- 3.2. Students pursuing the pathway are required to complete a 0.5 credit summer term bridge for direct entry to year 2 of the Psychology degree at Trent. Students are required to complete **PSYC 1030H: Introduction to Psychology Part 2: Social and Personality Perspectives** in the summer term following graduation from Fleming College and before September study begins at Trent. Should a student wish to not enroll in the bridge from Early Childhood Education to Psychology it will take a student longer than 3 academic years to complete all required courses and there will be missing pre-requisites and select course sequencing issues for degree requirement completion.
- 3.3. Students transferring through the articulation agreement will be eligible to enroll in the Teacher Education Stream, Primary/Junior Stream, at Trent University. As part of the pathway Trent University commits to waiving the written component of the application and will admit students if they meet the terms of the articulation agreement. The degree completion map in section 6.3 notes all course completion requirements for both the B.A. Honours in Psychology (Course Option) and requirements of the Emphasis in Teacher Education, as well as just the requirements for the B.A. Honours in Psychology (Course Option). Admission to the Teacher Education Stream does not guarantee admission into the Bachelor of Education program at Trent University.

4. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1. To qualify for this agreement, students must have:
 - successfully completed Fleming College's Early Childhood Education Diploma
 - a minimum overall average of 75%
- 4.2. Students must meet all specific admission and enrollment standards and requirements for the program and will be accepted subject to capacity if applicable.
- 4.3. Students applying for entry to Trent University through the pathway should apply via OUAC to Psychology to be considered for admission to Trent University. Students planning to enroll in the Teacher Education Stream should also email admissions@trentu.ca to advise of their plan to enroll in the stream, as well as whether they are enrolling in Arts or Science stream, if they are deemed eligible for receipt of the terms of the articulation agreement. Students should include their full name and OUAC reference number when sending this advisory e-mail.

5. TRANSFER OF CREDITS

5.1. Students graduating from the Early Childhood Education Diploma four semester program with a minimum average of 75% will be granted 5.0 credits towards the successful completion of a 20 credit Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology at Trent University. Credits will be transferred as follows:

5.2. As these credits recognize areas covered in Fleming College's Early Childhood Education Diploma rather than one-to-one course equivalents, numerical grades will not be recorded on the Trent transcript. Completion of these credits will be recognized with a pass grade.

6. PROGRAM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- 6.1. Upon admission to the Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology at Trent, students must satisfy all general education, graduation and major requirements as outlined in the university's undergraduate calendar. If a student does not have the prerequisite course required for entry into an upper level course, the student will be required to enroll in the prerequisite course(s).
- 6.2. If a student transfers to a different degree program, all transfer credits outlined in this agreement may not apply to the new degree program. It is the student's responsibility to consult an academic advisor and to notify the Registrar's Office of any program changes.
- 6.3. To satisfy the requirements of Trent's Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology or the Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology with an Emphasis in Teacher Education, students will need to complete the

following courses below in addition to the credits already granted. Degree requirements are subject to change at any time and the Academic Calendar should always be consulted prior to enrolling in courses to ensure requirements are being met.

6.4. Completion of required courses will vary on an individual basis based on the flexibility and course options within the Bachelor of Arts degree and specific program chosen. Students must achieve the following to fulfill Trent University degree requirements:

- i. A maximum of 7.0 credits at the 1000 level
- ii. 7.0 credits completed at the 3000 or 4000 level through both program requirements and general elective options
- iii. An overall minimum average of 65% in Trent University courses to obtain an Honours degree

Note: It is recommended that students transferring into the Bachelor of Arts degree meet with an Academic Advisor at Trent University prior to completing any course selections.

7. IMPLEMENTATION AND REVIEW

This agreement is subject to review whenever either party makes curricular changes that impact the agreement. When a change occurs, the program departments will notify their respective articulation designates so that the agreement can be updated. Articulation designates at each institution will review the agreement annually to ensure it is current. This Agreement may be terminated by either party. In this case, notice of one year is required. In the event of termination of the Agreement, every effort will be made to ensure that students currently enrolled in the program will not be affected.

8. ACCEPTANCE OF AGREEMENT

This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below and shall become effective as of the September 2019 intake and remain effective until a new agreement is entered into.

Trent University has eliminated the Emphasis in Education mentioned in Sections 3.3 and 6.3 of the original agreement. As a result, the Emphasis in Education is no longer a requirement of the Teacher Education Stream.
