ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN Sir Sandford Fleming College and Acadia University

The objectives of this agreement are to attract qualified students to Sir Sandford Fleming College and to Acadia University and to promote an easy and efficient transition of qualified transfer students from the Earth Resources Technician and the Environmental Technician programs at Sir Sandford Fleming College, to the Bachelor of Science (Geology or Environmental Science) degree program at Acadia University.

CONDITIONS

The following are the conditions of this agreement:

- 1. Sir Sandford Fleming College agrees to advise students of the provisions of this agreement.
- 2. Acadia University agrees to accept students who have successfully completed the Earth Resources Technician program at Sir Sandford Fleming College with a B-average or higher as third-year students in the BSc (Geology) program at Acadia University.
- 3. Acadia University agrees to accept students who have successfully completed the Environmental Technician program at Sir Sandford Fleming College with a B-average or higher into the BSc (Environmental Science) program at Acadia, giving credit for 51 hours toward the 120-hour degree.
- 4. Acadia University agrees to award credit for COOP 1900 and 2900 to students who have successfully completed a minimum of 900 hours of Co-op, or COOP 1900 to students who have successfully completed a minimum of 450 hours of Co-op, as part of the Earth Resources Technician program at Sir Sandford Fleming College.
- 5. At the request of either party, a review of the contents of this agreement will be conducted by the two institutions.
- 6. The agreement may only be altered or amended by the written consent of both parties.

TERMS AND TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

- 1. This articulation agreement shall commence on the date it is signed by both parties and will continue for a five-year period.
- 2. If this agreement is terminated, any transfer student from Sir Sandford Fleming College at Acadia University will be allowed to complete their program.
