



LETTER OF ARTICULATION

This Letter of Articulation is made between:

Justice Institute of British Columbia (JIBC) 715 McBride Boulevard New Westminster, BC V3L 5T4

And

Fleming College Fleming College 599 Brealey Drive Peterborough, Ontario K91 7B1

This Letter of Articulation constitutes an agreement between the Justice Institute of British Columbia (JIBC) and Fleming College. The participating units at the respective institutions are the School of Criminal Justice and Security at JIBC and the School of Justice and Business Studies at Fleming College.

Objective of the Agreement:

JIBC agrees to facilitate the block transfer of students who have graduated from the following Fleming College diploma programs into the Bachelors of Law Enforcement Studies (BLES):

- Police Foundations
- Community and Justice Services

Article 1: Details

- 1. Fleming College students will receive 60 transfer credits for entry into year 3 of the JIBC's Bachelors of Law Enforcement Studies (BLES) degree.
- 2. Fleming College students must meet all JIBC admissions criteria, deadlines and processes.
- 3. This agreement will start on September 1st 2014





Article 2: Commitments

JIBC agrees:

- 1. Those applicants from Fleming College who meet the requirements outlined above will be eligible for admissions to JIBC with 60 credits of block transfer into the BLES.
- 2. To provide Fleming College with updated information about the BLES on an annual basis, and
- 3. To notify Fleming College, with as much lead time as possible, about any changes to BLES requirements that are anticipated or approved.

Fleming College agrees to:

- Make information about this agreement and the BLES available to students
- Provide opportunity for representatives of JIBC to visit appropriate forums at Fleming College to disseminate information about the BLES
- Provide JIBC with updated information about Fleming College Police Foundations and Community and Justice Service Diplomas on an annual basis, and
- Notify JIBC, with as much lead time as possible, about any changes to the Police Foundations and Community and Justice Service Diplomas that are anticipated or approved.

Lialson:

Implementation of this agreement will be through the School of Justice and Business Studies at Fleming College, and JIBC Registrar's Office, in consultation with the appropriate authorities and Schools in the respective program areas.
