**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**

**Purpose:**

The purpose of this agreement is to provide students at Fleming College's Haliburton School of the Arts, enrolled in the Visual and Creative Arts Diploma (VCAD) the opportunity to transfer into a Bachelor's degree at NSCAD University.

**Eligibility:**

Graduates of the VCAD program with an average of C (2.00) or higher will be considered for admission to year (2) of the Bachelor of Fine Art (Visual Art or General Fine Art majors) on the basis of their academic standing, a portfolio review and subject to the terms and conditions outlined below

**Terms and Conditions:**

**Transfer to the Bachelor of Fine Art (Interdisciplinary)**

Graduates who complete in the VCAD program at Fleming College (specialist or generalist option) will be considered for admission to the second year of the BFA (Interdisciplinary) degree at NSCAD University.

Fleming College students qualifying for admission will receive the following credits on transfer:

### **Additional Requirements:**

Based on the Fleming College Diploma (2014), students admitted to the Bachelor of Fine Art (Visual Art and General Fine Art majors) will receive a total of 30 credits on transfer. The remaining credits will need to be completed at NSCAD.

Students must also complete the following course requirements or their equivalents to fully satisfy the foundation year requirements for NSCAD's Bachelor of Fine Art (Visual Art and General Fine Art majors):

FNDN 1800: Writing for the Arts (3 credits)  
FNDN 1600: Drawing II (3 credits)

Two courses (6 credits) of fundamentals must be selected from the following five courses:

FNDN 1310: Foundation Photography (3 credits)  
FNDN 1330: Foundation Video (3 credits)  
FNDN 1340: Foundation Wood/Metal (3 credits)  
FNDN 1350: Foundation Computer (3 credits)  
FNDN 1360: Foundation Movement Art (3 credits)

Additional Academic credits 12 credits

### **Each of the parties to this agreement hereto agrees:**

- To communicate with the other party about possible or anticipated changes to their program(s).
- To facilitate changes mutually agreed upon, in a timely fashion.
- To evaluate and update this articulation agreement prior to the end of the listed period of validity or sooner as needed.
- To promote the other party's prospective qualified students; each party will endeavor to link their website to the relevant program areas in the other's website.
- During the term of this agreement, each of the parties is granted a limited, non-transferable license to display trademarks, names or logos of the other party in order to promote the agreement.

### **Additional Information**




