MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between Faculty of Business, University of New Brunswick and Fleming College

This Memorandum of Understanding constitutes an agreement between the Faculty of Business, University of New Brunswick Saint John (UNBSJ) and Fleming College.

Objective of the Agreement

Graduates of any two-year diploma program at Fleming College, who have attained a cumulative grade point average of 70% or greater will be eligible to enter year three of the four-year **Bachelor of Applied Management (BAM)** at the University of New Brunswick, Saint John.

Depending on diploma program, students may be exempted from study in certain courses and therefore, requested to take alternate courses offered by the Faculty of Business. These exemptions will be noted in the student's file upon admission.

As a partner to this agreement, Fleming College agrees to:

- make information about this agreement available to students enrolled in their two-year programs,
- notify UNBSJ about any changes to program curricula which may impact transferability and assessments,
- provide opportunity for representatives of UNBSI to visit appropriate forums at Fleming College to disseminate information about the **BAM** program,
- promote this agreement in relevant marketing materials including online media.

As a partner to this agreement, UNBSJ agrees to:

- notify Fleming College about any changes to the **BAM** program curricula which may impact transferability and assessment,
- provide opportunity for representatives of Fleming College to visit appropriate forums at UNBSJ.
- promote this agreement in relevant marketing materials including online media.

Liaison

Implementation of this agreement will be through the Office of the Registrar at each institution, in consultation with the appropriate authorities in the respective programs.

Terms of the Agreement

This agreement shall take effect for an initial period of five years, commencing September 1, 2008. At the end of this term, the agreement may be extended for an additional period of time as agreed upon the parties and subject to the review and approval of the participating organizations. This agreement shall remain in effect unless terminated earlier by either party giving at least one (1) year prior written notice. In any event, termination shall be without penalty, and neither party shall be liable to the other for any monetary or other losses that may result. This agreement may only be amended in writing signed by or on behalf of the parties affected thereby.
