ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 1

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Arts in Information Systems Management

FC Programme: Internet Applications and Web Development.

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Diploma graduates of the Internet Applications and Web Development program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the Bachelor of Arts in Information Systems Management on the Web Technologies Stream. On successful completion of the BA with a 50% grade average, graduates will be eligible to enter Year 4 of the BA (Hons.) in Information Systems Management.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IO TI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT program, Fleming College graduates will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 2

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Arts in Information Systems Management

FC Programme: Office Administration - Executive.

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Diploma graduates of the Office Administration – Executive program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the Bachelor of Arts in Information Systems Management on the Business Administration Stream. On the successful completion of Year 3 of the BA graduates with a minimum 50% grade average will be eligible to enter Year 4 of the BA (Hons) in Information Systems Management.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IO TI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 3

ITT Programme: B.Sc. in Information Technology Support
B.Sc (Hons) in Computer Service Management

FC Programme: Computer Engineering - Technician

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Diploma graduates of the Computer Engineering – Technician program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the B.Sc. in Information Technology Support, subject to successful completion of specified alignment studies. Graduates of the B.Sc. in Information Technology Support, with a minimum grade average of 50%, are eligible to enter Year 4 of the B.Sc. (Hons) in Computer Service Management.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IO TI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

Prior to entry, diploma graduates are required to successfully undertake a module/course in Database Concepts and a module/course in HTML and CSS (Cascading Style Sheets).

Exemptions

Students may qualify for an exemption in Wan Services and Security. This will be considered on an individual case basis.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 4

ITT Programme: B.Sc. (Hons) in Computer Service Management.

FC Programme: Computer Engineering – Technology (Advanced Diploma).

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Advanced Diploma graduates of the Computer Engineering – Technology program are eligible to enter Year 4 of the B.Sc. (Hons) in Computer Service Management subject to the successful completion of the prescribed alignment studies.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IO TI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Advanced Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

Prior to entry, advanced diploma graduates are required to successfully undertake the following:

- An introduction to relational databases and SQL programming
- A refresher course on Linux

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Arts in Travel and Tourism Management

FC Programme: Tourism and Travel

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Diploma graduates of the Tourism and Travel program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the Bachelor of Arts in Travel and Tourism Management. Graduates of the BA in Travel and Tourism Management, with a minimum grade average of 50% are eligible to enter Year 4 of BA (Hons) in Travel and Tourism Management.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IO TI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Arts in Hotel Management

FC Programme: Hotel and Restaurant Management

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Diploma graduates of the Hotel and Restaurant Management program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the Bachelor of Arts in Hotel Management. Graduates of the BA in Hotel Management, with a minimum grade average of 50%, are eligible to enter Year 4 of the BA (Hons) in Hotel Management

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IOI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 7

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Arts in Hotel Management

FC Programme: Hospitality Administration

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Advanced Diploma graduates of the Hospitality Administration program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the Bachelor of Arts in Hotel Management. Graduates of the BA in Hotel Management, with a minimum grade average of 50%, are eligible to enter Year 4 of the BA (Hons.) in Hotel Management.

Depending on the "Business Electives" successfully completed on the Advanced Diploma in Hospitality Administration graduates may be considered eligible to enter Year 4. This possible route will be considered on an individual applicant basis.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IOI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Diploma/Advanced Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

None

Exemptions

To be considered on an individual applicant basis for Advanced Diploma graduates entering Year 3. This consideration will be undertaken while at IT Tralee.

This program was introduced at ITT in the academic year 2013-14 and therefore will not have a third year group until the academic year 2015-16.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 8

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Arts in Culinary Arts

FC Programme: Culinary Management

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Diploma graduates of the Culinary Management program are eligible to enter Year 3 Bachelor of Arts in Culinary Arts.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IOI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

None

Additional Notes

Year 3 of this program/course will be offered subject to demand.

A BA (Hons) in Culinary Arts is currently being developed at ITT.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 9

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Care and Education

FC Programme: Early Childhood Education

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Diploma graduates of the Early Childhood Education program are eligible to enter Semester 3 (September – January) and progress from there to undertake Semester 6 (January – May) for the award of Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Care and Education. In addition students will undertake specified alignment studies as outlined below. Graduates of the BA in Early Childhood Care and Education, with a minimum grade average of 50%, are then eligible to study Semesters 7 and 8 for the award of BA (Hons) in Early Childhood Care and Education.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IOITI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

In parallel with their studies of Semesters 3 and 6, students will complete a Practice Placement Portfolio. The completion of this Portfolio will involve site visits.

Additional Notes

As Fleming College diploma graduates have already undertaken work placement in a Canadian regulated environment they are not required to do so again in the Republic of Ireland.

Police clearance is necessary as students may be required to interact with children or young people while on site visits.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 10

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Science in Health and Leisure with Massage

FC Programme: Massage Therapy (Advanced Diploma)

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Advanced Diploma graduates of the Massage Therapy program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the Bachelor of Science in Health and Leisure with Massage subject to the successful completion of the alignment studies prescribed below.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IOI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an IT Tralee programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Advanced Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

Fleming College graduates will undertake a suitable course/module to achieve the learning outcomes of the Research Methods: Measurement Concepts on Year 2 of the IT Tralee program. This course/module will be completed prior to entry onto the ITT program. ITT recommends that graduates undertake the *Statistics* module from Mohawk College which is available through the Ontario Learn Network. An alternative module with equivalent learning outcomes may equally be undertaken but its suitability will be determined by ITT in advance.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 11

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Business in Marketing

FC Programme: Business Administration – Marketing (Advanced Diploma)

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario Colleges Advanced Diploma graduates of the Business Administration – Marketing program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the Bachelor of Business in Marketing, subject to the successful completion of the prescribed alignment studies. Graduates of the B.Bus. in Marketing, with a minimum grade average of 50%, will be eligible to enter Year 4 for the award of B.Bus. (Hons.) in Marketing.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IoTI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Advanced Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

Prior to entry to Year 3, advanced diploma graduates are required to successfully complete modules/courses in:

- Business and Contract Law
- Management Accounting

Exemptions

Students may be exempted from modules (maximum of one per semester) where the learning outcomes of those modules have already been successfully achieved. This will be considered on an individual student basis while at ITT.

Additional Notes

This articulation is aligned to the CO-IoTI Memorandum of Arrangement in the field of Business (incorporating Marketing, Human Resource Management, Accounting and Business Administration).

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 12

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Business in Accounting

FC Programme: Business Administration – Accounting (Advanced Diploma)

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario Colleges Advanced Diploma graduates of the Business Administration – Accounting program are eligible to enter Year 3 of the Bachelor of Business in Accounting. Graduates of the B.Bus. in Accounting, with a minimum grade average of 50%, are eligible to enter Year 4 of the B.Bus. (Hons.) in Accounting.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IOITI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Advanced Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

IT Tralee recommends that Fleming College students, considering transfer to ITT, should elect Database Fundamentals in Semester 3 and Computer and Information Systems in Semester 4.

Exemptions

Students may be exempted from modules (maximum of one per semester) where the learning outcomes of those modules have already been successfully achieved. This will be considered on an individual student basis while at IT Tralee.

This articulation is aligned to the CO-IOITI Memorandum of Arrangement in the field of Business (incorporating Marketing, Human Resource Management, Accounting and Business Administration).

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENT 13

ITT Programme: Bachelor of Business in Management or Marketing

FC Programme: Business Administration (Advanced Diploma)

Recommended Point of Entry

Ontario College Advanced Diploma graduates of the Business Administration program are eligible for entry Year 3 of the Bachelor of Business in Management or in Marketing, subject to the successful completion of the prescribed alignment studies. Graduates of the B.Bus. in Management/Marketing, with a minimum grade average of 50%, are eligible to enter Year 4 of the B.Bus. (Hons.) in their chosen stream.

Grade Requirements

As per the CO-IoTI Memorandum of Arrangement, to be eligible for consideration for entry to an ITT programme, Fleming College students will have achieved a minimum grade average of 60% at Advanced Diploma level. This entry grade requirement is subject to periodic review.

Alignment Study Requirements

Prior to entry to Year 3, advanced diploma graduates are required to successfully complete a module/course in:

- Management Accounting

Exemptions

Students may be exempted from modules/courses in Year 3 (maximum of one per semester) where the learning outcomes of those modules have already been successfully achieved. This will be considered on an individual student basis.
