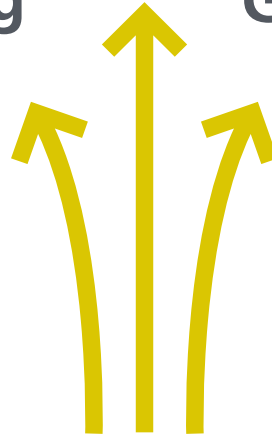

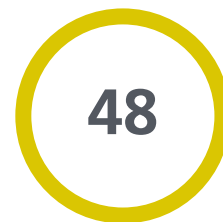

OUR COMMITMENT

Fleming College continues to develop innovative and sector leading pathways. It is our commitment to provide clear and accessible academic pathways for all programs to enable mobility into and within the College, and between academic institutions. These pathways will minimize unnecessary duplication of learning and provide a seamless transition between academic credentials.

DUAL CREDIT OPPORTUNITIES.

Start your post secondary education pathway while still in high school through the Dual Credit program. You'll gain the college experience while earning high school and college credits at the same time. Dual Credit courses are offered at no cost for secondary school students.

There are more than 25 different dual credit courses offered each year in partnership with 30 different high schools, across seven school boards. Successful students may be eligible to transfer their credits towards many Ontario College certificate, diploma, or advanced diploma programs.



The most popular Fleming College programs chosen by Dual Credit students are: Police Foundations, Esthetician, Social Service Worker, Practical Nursing, and Electrical Techniques.

One popular Dual Credit course is MECH 254: Welding Processes and Practices, which is offered in our state-of-the-art welding shop. This course teaches the techniques of fusion welding,

brazing and cutting. Students also learn and apply safe handling procedures for the use of potentially dangerous equipment in accordance with industry standards. This course is part of seven Ontario College certificate and Ontario College diploma programs offered at Fleming.

FEATURED PATHWAY

SCHOOL OF JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FLEMING COLLEGE – PETERBOROUGH, ONTARIO

Credentials: Ontario College Diploma in Paralegal and Ontario College Diploma in Law Clerk

Requirements: Ontario Secondary School Diploma, including Grade 12 College English

Fleming's Paralegal program is designed to prepare you to meet Ontario's paralegal licensing standards and is accredited by The Law Society of Upper Canada. Teamed with Fleming's Law Clerk program, the first three semesters are highly integrated, and include courses in business and contract law, litigation, writing, criminal law, evidence, advocacy, small claims law, practice management and legal accounting. Graduates will be able to assist lawyers or work on their own, in tasks such as interviewing clients, conducting legal research, preparing documents, searching real estate and corporate registries, and preparing cases for trial.



Jessica Polley was hired as a Paralegal and Legal Assistant at MacDonald, Charette & Associates in Cobourg before graduating.

Jessica chose Fleming College, 10 years after highschool, because of the dual diploma option. "I was able to find and obtain a position in my chosen field of study before I had even completed both of my programs. I would not have been able to do that without the education I recieved at Fleming," said Jessica, who now has her Paralegal License and credits her dual diplomas for having a wider range of employment opportunities.

"The amazing faculty made learning something new a lot less scary. They truly want to see you succeed and are happy to help when you have questions." Before graduating from Fleming, Jessica was hired at

MacDonald, Charette & Associates in Cobourg, Ont. They worked around her school schedule so that she was able to finish classes, then they hired her full-time as a Paralegal and Legal Assistant after classes were complete.

Jessica said that the skills she developed at Fleming are applicable to her job. "We drafted the majority of the documents and materials in class that I draft on a daily basis in my job. We also would have to file our completed documents with the court clerk as part of our assignments," she explained.

TRENT UNIVERSITY – PETERBOROUGH, ONTARIO

Credential: Bachelor of Education
– Indigenous

Fleming Program: General Arts & Science – University Transfer

Trent University will grant successful candidates four credits toward the 25-credit degree program. “Through this pathway, we will support Indigenous learners who are looking to fast-track from Fleming College into this specialized Bachelor of Education degree,” said Dr. Cathy Bruce, Dean of the School of Education and Professional Learning at Trent University. Reflecting Trent’s ground-breaking leadership in Indigenous Studies, the new Indigenous Bachelor of Education will put graduates of the program in a unique position to teach non-Indigenous students, and to further their understanding of Indigenous issues.



Sarah Healey completed her Masters in Sustainability Studies at Trent University in 2018.

After high school, Sarah enrolled in Fleming College’s International Trade program and participated in the Fleming International Learning Experience (FILE) trip to Europe with the School of Business. During her time at Fleming, Sarah said she matured, developed a passion for learning and business, explored new languages, and made lifelong friends. “My experience was clarifying,” she said. “I entered Fleming a completely different person, than I left.” One course in the International Trade program that impacted Sarah was Corporate Social Responsibility. “The entire course changed my outlook on education and, as a result, my life,” said Sarah, adding that she decided to continue her education after Fleming to become a stronger candidate in the workforce.

“By furthering my education, I believed this would provide me the opportunity to advocate for businesses becoming more sustainable and transparent in their practices.”

After completing her advanced diploma in International Trade in 2014, Sarah used an education pathway to enter into the third year of Trent University’s Bachelor of Business Administration program. She said she was prepared for the transition to university because she developed time management, project management, teamwork and leadership skills at Fleming College.

Sarah completed her undergraduate degree in 2016, her masters in 2018, and is now working at Peterborough’s Innovation Cluster. “I used to think that if I didn’t go straight to university from high school I’d never make it there,” said Sarah. “Seven years later I’ve graduated from my masters and have nine years of post-secondary education in less than seven years. If I can do it, you can too!”

VANCOUVER ISLAND UNIVERSITY – NANAIMO, BRITISH COLUMBIA

Credential: Master of Geographic Information Systems Applications

Fleming Programs:

Geographic Information Systems - Applications or Cartographic Specialist

Vancouver Island University allows Geographic Information Systems graduates to enter their second year of VIU's Master of GIS Applications program. "This agreement is ground-breaking. VIU has acknowledged our 10-month program as equivalent to one year at the master's degree level," said Linda Skilton, former Dean of the School of Environmental and Natural Resource Sciences. "This pathway is extremely attractive to students as it reduces the time required to complete a graduate degree by one year."



Crystal Smith was hired as a field assistant with the department of Natural Resources, Geological Division in 2017 and was able to explore by helicopter as part of her job.

Crystal Smith was stuck between a rock and a hard place when considering her post secondary options for geology. As a kinesthetic learner, the applied approach of college appealed to Crystal; but industry professionals recommended a university degree. Luckily for Crystal, Fleming College's Earth Resources Technician Co-op program offers the best of both worlds through education pathways.

"I would recommend the education pathway [with Acadia University] to any Fleming grad that thrives to learn more about geology and would like to travel and experience the East Coast."

Crystal shared the knowledge and skills she gained at Fleming with her peers at Acadia, and noted that Fleming prepared her for university in terms of time-management and hard work.

Crystal's advice for current students is to know when you need motivation and to seek it.

"I've always felt inspired to learn more after listening to professional geologists tell their stories and share their great adventures in the field," said Crystal. "My favorite was a lecture told by a Fleming graduate who also transferred to Acadia, who came and gave a speech to undergraduate students. I could relate to the academic route and at the same time the worldly adventures that person had throughout their career gave me enough inspiration that moment to gladly study more."

Eligible graduates can complete a diploma and a degree in four years. Students enter directly into the third year of Wilfrid Laurier's Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Studies. Laurier's Environmental Studies program combines natural and social sciences to better understand the human relationship with the natural environment. Students focus on issues such as sustainability in land and water management, and acquire applied skills in environmental impact assessment, geovisualization, remote sensing, and research methods. Hands-on experiential, field, and community-engaged learning opportunities are built into all aspects of the program.

"The nature and depth of the Fleming programs make them a natural fit with Laurier's Environmental Studies program," said Sean Doherty, Chair of Laurier's Department of Geography and Environmental Studies. "We look forward to immersing students into our department where they can confront challenging environmental issues, further expand and put into practice their impressive skill set, and engage with our existing students in ways that raise the profile of the whole program."

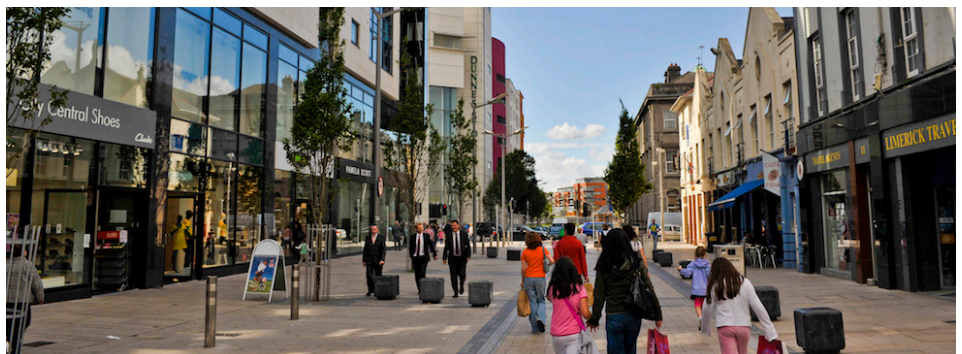
