Agreement for a Programming Linkage Between Fleming College and Lakehead University

This initiative links the HBOR program at Lakehead University and the Ecotourism and Adventure Tourism Management programs at Fleming College. Students who complete the requirements as per the linkage model and maintain good academic standing will receive a degree from Lakehead and a certificate from Fleming. The linkage model is attached to this agreement.

Qualified students will enroll in the Certificate Program at Fleming's Haliburton campus for the winter term of either their third or fourth year. Students will be accepted conditionally into the Certificate programs on the basis of their standing in the HBOR program and other criteria established by Fleming College. Accepted students will be required to fulfill course work and/or additional work outlined in the model for entry into the Certificate programs.

Fleming will give advanced standing for entry into the winter term of the Certificate programs for successful completion of a set of Lakehead courses. For the purposes of this agreement, this set of courses is equivalent to the fall term of the Fleming diploma programs. Identified gaps in course content will be dealt with in two ways: through a day-long workshop at Lakehead; and, on a case by case basis by the Fleming instructor during the fall term while students are at Lakehead and during the winter term at Fleming (Haliburton).

Students who are interested in the program will apply to Fleming through the OCAS application procedure in the year preceding desired registration. The student must identify the Ecotourism or Adventure Tourism program. Fleming College will offer provisional acceptance and the student will be required to submit official transcripts. The student will register for Fall courses at Lakehead in order to meet the requirements for acceptance. Following participation in the Fleming program students return to Lakehead to complete the HBOR.

Students who participate in this option will complete four full years of course work (over nine terms of study) at Lakehead and complete one term at Fleming (within the last four terms of study). Students will pay applicable fees and tuition at the institution they are attending in any particular term.
