



Fleming/Loyalist – Educational Assistant (EA) Program Articulation Agreement

Fleming & Loyalist College have entered into a co-operative agreement to enable the graduates of the Loyalist EA certificate program to complete the Fleming EA diploma program.

- 1. Individuals who have completed the Loyalist EA certificate program will be given credit for courses in the Fleming EA Diploma Program as shown in the attached table part A.
- 2. Loyalist College will provide the additional courses shown in the attached table part B for credit in the Fleming courses as listed.
- 3. Fleming College will deliver the courses shown in the attached table part C.
- 4. To be eligible for a Fleming EA diploma, individuals must complete all of parts A, B, and C.
- 5. Students of the Loyalist College program must complete all course requirements in Parts A and B before advancing to Part C at Fleming College
- 6. All of the courses will be delivered at/through the Loyalist, Bancroft Campus.
- 7. Participation in this program does not entitle participants direct access to or advanced standing in the regular Fleming EA diploma program.
- 8. Official record of completion of courses in parts A & B will be provided by Loyalist College to Fleming College for each participant.
- 9. Fleming College must approve, in advance, all courses identified in parts B & C including the course outline/syllabus/assessment of learning and the instructor.
- 10. Loyalist College will register, set fees and be responsible for all expenses for the delivery of courses in parts A & B.

- 11. Fleming College will register, set fees and be responsible for all expenses for the delivery of courses in part C.
- 12. Eligible General Education Elective courses for part B will be determined based on CSAC criteria and reviewed by the Fleming General Education Elective co-ordinator.
- 13. A minimum number of participants in each course will be established by Loyalist for those courses in parts A & B and by Fleming for those courses in parts C.
- 14. The requirements and conditions for completing Field Practice & Evaluation (1110238) and Field Practice & Evaluation Part A & B (1110529) will be determined by the Fleming EA program coordinator for each individual participant.
- 15. This agreement will be administered through Fleming Training Services except for approval of course outline/syllabus/assessment of learning and the instructor which shall be the responsibility of the Fleming EA program coordinator.
- 16. This agreement will be formally reviewed biannually by both Fleming & Loyalist.
