

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

SIR SANDFORD FLEMING COLLEGE

and

UNIVERSITY OF WINDSOR

Approved by Senate

May 11, 2005

Proposal:

FASS proposes that the University of Windsor and Sir Sandford Fleming College enter into an articulation agreement with respect to the College's one-year Certificate in General Arts and Science and the University's Bachelor of Arts and BSW Degrees.

Background:

The courses in the College's Certificate in Arts and Science program have been examined by the appropriate University of Windsor programs, and the equivalencies listed below have been established. As a result, we propose granting up to one term of credit towards the BA or BSW University degree.

Details:

Students who have completed the one-year Certificate in General Arts and Science from Sir Sandford Fleming with a cumulative average grade of B may receive up to five university credits for the following courses (or their equivalents), provided they passed the respective college courses with a grade of B- or better:

Students will not be restricted to enrolling in a specific program (e.g., History). The course credits received will be applicable to any BA or BSW program in the Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences, and students will have to meet all regular requirements for their respective major.
