### **Objectives**

The aim of the Agreement is to increase educational mobility between the two institutions by making Memorial University's Bachelor of Technology degree program available to graduates of the College's applied science and engineering technology, and health science technology, diploma programs.

#### **Terms of Agreement**

This Agreement shall be in effect for a period of five (5) years. It may be reviewed annually and modified as required by the partners.

#### **Responsibilities of the Partners**

To meet the aims of the Agreement, the partners will:

- 1. determine the terms of the specific articulation agreement for the Bachelor of Technology at Sir Sandford Fleming College;
- 2. annually review the success of the Bachelor of Technology;
- 3. ensure continued exploration and implementation of articulation as new programs are offered,
- 4. identify and co-ordinate joint marketing strategies for the promotion of the articulation agreements.

## **Program Articulation Agreements**

Program Articulation Agreements will provide access to Memorial University's Bachelor of Technology to:

- all 3-year nationally accredited applied science and engineering technology programs;
- all 3-year nationally accredited health science technology programs;

As new programs are offered by either partner, articulation will be explored and implemented where feasible.

### Areas of Co-operation

The Marine Institute and Sir Sandford Fleming College may co-operate in the marketing and promotion to the community, to students and to business and industry of the articulation and collaborative initiatives that are established between the partners.

#### **Cost Sharing**

The Marine Institute and Sir Sandford Fleming College agree that all costs associated with components of this Agreement will be shared using existing funds.
