

Articulation Agreement (Renewal)

between

OCAD University

and

Sir Sandford Fleming College of Applied Arts and Technology

2016 – 2019

This articulation agreement sets forth the guidelines under which graduates of the Sir Sandford Fleming College of Applied Arts and Technology (Fleming College) Visual and Creative Arts Diploma (VCAD) may be admitted to the OCAD University (OCAD U) Photography (BFA) Program.

Purpose:

The purpose of the agreement is to give graduates of Fleming College's VCAD Program the opportunity to apply for upper-year placement in OCAD U's Photography (BFA) Program.

Eligibility:

As per the equivalencies outlined in Appendices B and C, OCAD U recognizes Fleming College's VCAD Program as the academic basis for admission to the OCAD U Photography (BFA) Program. Graduates of the Fleming program who have completed the diploma with an overall average of at least C (65%) are eligible to apply for upper-year entry into OCAD U's Photography (BFA) Program.

Applicants to OCAD U under this agreement must have graduated with the Fleming College Visual and Creative Arts Diploma Program no later than June for September admission.

Articulating students are strongly encouraged to seek advising at OCAD U before registering for courses to ensure degree requirements will be met.

Each of the parties to this agreement hereto agrees:

- i. To communicate with the other party about possible or anticipated changes to their program(s).
- ii. To facilitate changes mutually agreed upon, in a timely fashion.
- iii. To evaluate and update this articulation agreement prior to the end of the listed period of validity or sooner as needed.
- iv. To promote the other party's programs to prospective qualified students; each party will endeavor to link their website to the relevant program areas on the other's website.
- v. During the term of this agreement, each of the parties is granted a limited, non-transferable license to display trademarks, names or logos of the other party in order to promote the agreement.

Additional Information:

Applicants for upper-year placement through this articulation agreement should familiarize themselves with all relevant information on OCAD U's website, paying special attention to the academic requirements set out in this agreement (Appendix A).

All applications for admission must be made through the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC). Fleming College graduates applying for admission under this articulation agreement must use the appropriate program code from the Articulation Agreement category on the OUAC application.

In the event that this articulation agreement is terminated, all participating students who commenced their studies at OCAD U before the date of termination will be permitted to complete their approved course of study.

Term:

Upon signing, the agreement will be effective for three years with the opportunity for annual evaluation and review. The agreement may be amended or renewed upon the mutual consent of both Fleming College and OCAD U. This agreement shall remain in effect unless terminated earlier by each party with at least one (1) year prior written notice.



APPENDIX A: Program of Study (based on 2016/2017 requirements)

Proposed program of study for students articulating from the Fleming College VCAD Program into the OCAD U Photography (BFA) Program.

Appendix B: Credit Equivalencies for Articulation

The following required courses in the Fleming College VCAD Program are equivalent to 4.0 credits of a 20.0 credit BFA degree Program in Photography at OCAD U for the purpose of articulation.

These equivalencies form the basis of the articulation agreement. Upon admission, graduates of the VCAD Program will be required to demonstrate completion of the program with an overall minimum average of C (65%).

In addition, students applying to OCAD U’s Photography (BFA) Program must have completed the full Photo Arts Specialist Option or, at least, the courses in the same Specialist Option listed below.
