# **Education Pathways Terminology**

#### **Articulation Agreement**

An agreement, typically between two institutions, that authorizes studies undertaken in specific programs to be credited toward direct entry and/or advanced standing into a specific program at the receiving institution.

#### **Bilateral Agreement**

An agreement outlined between two institutions and two specific programs of similar content.

## **Block transfer credit**

The transfer and granting of credit for a group of completed courses from one institution to another without requiring course-by-course assessments.

#### **Bridge program**

A set of courses designed specifically to provide a person who already possesses certain qualifications with the additional skills and knowledge required for admission into a specific program. Ie. Before transferring from a diploma to a degree, a student might need to complete summers courses in a bridge program at the receiving institution.

## Course to course credit transfer

The process of granting credit for a course (or courses) from one institution to another by completing a comparison of course content and learning outcomes for each individual course.

## Transfer credit

The acceptance or recognition of credits by a host institution on the basis of successful completion of courses at another educational institution in order to minimize the duplication of learning. Can also be called advanced standing.

## **Dual Diploma**

An agreement between different programs within Fleming College to allow students to earn two diplomas in three years.

## **Multilateral Agreement**

An agreement outlined between several institutions.

## **Ontario Council on Articulation and Transfer (ONCAT)**

Member-driven organization created to enhance student pathways and reduce barriers for students looking to transfer among Ontario's 45 publicly funded postsecondary institutions; works with all publicly funded colleges and universities in Ontario to enable the system of credit transfer to develop as rapidly as possible, while also respecting institutional autonomy.

#### Ontransfer.ca

Website database maintained by ONCAT which provides students with up-to-date, authoritative information on block credit agreements, and pathways between postsecondary institutions in Ontario.

#### 2+2 degree

A type of articulation agreement between two postsecondary institutions which allows a student to complete 2 years at a college (earning a diploma) and the last 2 years at a university (earning a degree).
