- The Following degree requirements have been changed to the Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in Policing and Community Well-being program:
 - o 2.5 PLCW credits at the 4000 level has now been reduced to 1.5 credits
 - 1.0 SOCI credit from SOCI 2430H, 2610H or 2615H has now be changed to 0.5 SOCI credit from SOCI 2430H, 2610H or 2615H
 - PLCW 3006H Diversity and Exclusion has been changed to PLCW 2005H
- The Following degree requirements have been changed to the Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in Policing and Community Well-being program:
 - PLCW 3005H Community Problem-Solving and Analysis has been removed as a degree requirement
