This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which shall become effective as of the Fall 2022 intake at Trent University. These changes will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new agreement is entered in to, whichever occurs first.

The following changes have occurred at Trent University:

- The following degree requirement have been added to the Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in Policing and Community Well-being program:
  - PLCW 1001H – Introduction to Policing and Community Well-being Part 1
  - PLCW 1002H – Introduction to Policing and Community Well-being Part 2
  - 0.5 PLCW credit at the 2000 level or beyond in addition to the above
- The Following degree requirements have been changed to the Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in Policing and Community Well-being program:
  - 2.5 PLCW credits at the 4000 level has now been reduced to 1.5 credits
  - 1.0 SOCI credit from SOCI 2430H, 2610H or 2615H has now be changed to 0.5 SOCI credit from SOCI 2430H, 2610H or 2615H
  - PLCW 3006H Diversity and Exclusion has been changed to PLCW 2005H
- The Following degree requirements have been changed to the Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in Policing and Community Well-being program:
  - PLCW 3005H – Community Problem-Solving and Analysis has been removed as a degree requirement

These changes specifically refer to Section 6 of the Agreement.
