



Revised Articulation Agreement November 2012

Fleming College and Trent University

General Arts and Science - University Transfer Option

Introduction

This agreement establishes the principles, guidelines, and procedures governing admission and assessment of selected qualified students to enter a *Bachelor of Arts* or *Bachelor of Science* program at Trent University on an advanced standing basis, subsequent to successful completion of the *General Arts and Science – University Transfer Option* at Fleming College. Hereafter, this collaborative effort will be referred to as the "articulation agreement."

Purpose

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to permit qualified graduates of the one-year General Arts and Science – University Transfer Option program at Fleming College to enter a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree program at Trent University.

Objectives

- To outline the process for admission to Trent University for qualified graduates of the specified program at Fleming College and general conventions regarding advanced standing credit to be applied towards the degree at Trent University
- 2) To outline a process for periodic review and assessment of all aspects of the articulation agreement.

Conditions and Terms of the Agreement

- 1) Fleming College and Trent University agree to set up a joint committee to oversee the administration of the articulation agreement.
- 2) Joint committee responsibilities include, but are not limited to: application procedures, an annual review of courses, enrolment data, student performance, student supports, administrative matters, and all other pertinent issues, as necessary. This activity will take place on an annual basis, to be established at a mutually convenient time for both parties. The Committee must ensure that the University Transfer Option courses maintain the quality of curriculum, expectations, instruction and assessment expected of Trent first-year courses.
- 3) Transfer credit will proceed in accordance with the following:
 - a. Upon successful completion of the General Arts and Science University Transfer Option program at Fleming College, students with a minimum 70%

average overall and a minimum of 65% in each of the required courses will be eligible to make application to a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science program at Trent University on an advanced standing basis.

- b. Trent University will grant direct entry and assign 5 transfer credits, as outlined in Appendix A, towards the successful completion of a degree program.
- c. Upon admission to a Trent University Program, students are required to meet both the Trent University and specific department/program requirements as outlined in the Trent University academic calendar.
- 4) Students who meet the minimum average required for admission to the University as outlined in the academic calendar, but who do not meet the requirements of this articulation agreement, will be considered for admission and for potential transfer credit eligibility, on an individual basis.

Review of Agreement

This agreement replaces the revised articulation agreement, signed in January, 2007. The agreement will be reviewed annually and fully assessed every three years. This agreement may be terminated by either party with one year of notice. In the event of termination of the agreement, every effort will be made to ensure that students currently enrolled in the program will not be affected.

Appendix A

Summary of transfer credits and degree completion requirements for graduates of Fleming College's General Arts and Science – University Transfer Option

The purpose of this agreement is to permit qualified students from the General Arts and Science – University Transfer Option program at Fleming College to enter a degree program at Trent University on an advanced standing basis. These students will be awarded 5 transfer credits, as specified below. To complete the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree, students are required to meet both the Trent University and specific department/program requirements as outlined in the Trent University academic calendar.

To qualify for the terms of this agreement, Fleming College General Arts and Science – University Transfer Option graduates must have:

- an average of 70% overall, and
- no less than 65% in any of the 12 courses required in the program.

Each transfer credit course grade will be calculated by averaging across both terms.

Entering Trent, qualified students will be granted the following 5.0 transfer credits:

1.0 ENGL 1000Y

0.5 PHIL 1000H and 0.5 PHIL 1100H

0.5 PSYC 1020H and 0.5 PSYC 1030H

0.5 SOCI 1001H and 0.5 SOCI 1002H

1.0 ARTS, unassigned 1000 level

Note: Numerical grades will not be recorded on the Trent transcript. Completion of these credits will be recognized with a "Pass" grade.
