This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which shall become effective as of the Spring 2023 intake at Trent University. These changes will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new agreement is entered into, whichever occurs first.

The following change will occur in Fleming College’s Protection, Security and Investigation Diploma starting in Fall 2022:

- GNED 49 – Introduction to Indigenous Studies (45 hours) will be replaced with INDG 49 – Introduction to Indigenous Studies (45 Hours)

These changes specifically refer to Section 5 of the Agreement.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (HONOURS), POLICING AND COMMUNITY WELL-BEING TRANSFER CREDITS

Students who are eligible, graduating from Fleming College’s Protection, Security and Investigation Diploma program with a minimum average of 75%, will be granted 5.0 credits towards the successful completion of a 20.0 credit Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Policing and Community Well-being at Trent University.
