I am writing on behalf of the Australian Catholic University (ACU National), one of 38 Australian Government funded universities in Australia. It is my pleasure as the Director of International, to introduce ACU National and its programs.

ACU National offers a wide range of programs to over 13,000 local and international students. Programs of study include Arts, Business, Education, Environmental Science, Exercise Science, Hotel Management, Information Systems, Music, Nursing, Psychology, Social Science, Justice Studies, Youth Studies, Social Work, Theology, and Visual Arts & Design. The University awards meet the requirements of the Australian Qualifications Framework and are recognised world-wide.

ACU National has six campuses in the major centres of Brisbane, Canberra, Sydney (2) and Melbourne as well as in Ballarat in rural Victoria. It is open to students and staff regardless of their beliefs and backgrounds and is committed to excellence in research, teaching and learning in an international context. Students from 60 different countries study at ACU National which, because of its small, attractive and well resourced campuses, is recognised for its close working relationship between students and teachers.

ACU National recognises qualifications of many colleges and educational providers throughout the world at diploma level. It accepts such diplomas as entry qualifications with advanced standing into its undergraduate programs.

The University has recently engaged the services Dr Joe Relich of Relcan Educational Consultants to advise on the feasibility of program articulations, specifically with the Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology in Ontario (ACAATO) as they are highly regarded here in Australia. Dr Relich has provided considerable insight into the colleges e.g., the delivery of programs and the quality of graduates. He has worked closely with several faculty members and the ACU National International Office in determining the congruence of undergraduate programs with those college programs that are mandated by the Ontario Ministry of Education. While this work is on-going, the Faculty of Business has now recognised the merit and quality of Advanced Diplomas in Business granted through the ACAATO group of colleges. The purpose of this letter is to advise you that ACU National will accept the completion of an Advanced Diploma in Business from Fleming College as a qualifying entry point into the third year of a related three year undergraduate degree at ACU National. . .

Please find attached a list of programs and the related ACU National degrees into which they will articulate. This arrangement is valid for three years (3) from the date of this notification and will be reviewed at the end of this period. It is also possible that over time, programs from faculties other than business will be deemed to meet the requirements for articulation. Should this be the case, I will ensure that an update will be provided by the ACU National International Office.

ACU National does not seek a formal agreement for these articulations and simply wishes to inform your college that students with appropriate qualifications would be welcome to apply for further studies. We would be pleased if you could inform your students of this additional pathway and I enclose some further information for you to review. Publication of this information for general consumption by students, staff and any other interested party is entirely a matter for the College to determine as per its general practices and requirements.
