ARTICULATION AGREEMENT #4309

BETWEEN

THE SIR SANDFORD FLEMING COLLEGE OF APPLIED ARTS AND TECHNOLOGY'S ONTARIO COLLEGE DIPLOMA IN SOCIAL SERVICES WORKER

AND

TRENT UNIVERSITY'S BACHELOR OF SOCIAL WORK (HONOURS)

This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which shall become effective as of the Fall 2022, intake at Trent University. These changes will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new agreement is entered in to, whichever occurs first.

The following changes have occurred at Trent University: SWRK 3000Y can now be used to satisfy the requirements for the general years of the Bachelor of Social Work (Honours) program.

- Students from Fleming College's Social Services Worker Diploma program are granted 6.0 transfer credits upon admission and are required to take an additional 4.0 credits to meet specific program requirements to apply for the third year of the program, they will need to complete an additional 10.0 credits to fulfill department degree requirements. The Department of Social Work strongly recommends that student complete an additional 5.0 credits (instead 4.0 credits) during their first year of study at Trent University.
- The following Courses Student Still Need to Take at Trent have changed:
 - 2.5 credits at the 2000 level or beyond in the Humanities and/or Social Sciences and/or Psychology has been reduced to 2.0 credits.
 - o 0.5 credits in addition to the above has changed to the requirement being fulfilled

These changes specifically refer to Sections 6 of the Agreement.
