Re: Agreement defining a pathway for international students to enter degree studies at Trent University through Trent ESL and the Fleming College University Transfer Program

Dear Dr. Khan,

This letter provides notice that The Sir Sandford Fleming College of Applied Arts and Technology (Fleming College) requests to terminate the **Agreement defining a pathway for international students to enter degree studies at Trent University through Trent ESL and the Fleming College University Transfer Program** signed between Fleming College and Trent University in 2012. Termination of the Agreement is effective July 1, 2023.

As stated in Article E: Review of Agreement

This agreement is effective upon signing, and will apply to admissions beginning in Fall 2012. The agreement will be reviewed every three years and may be terminated by either party, given one year of notice. In the event of termination of the agreement, every effort will be made to ensure that students currently enrolled in the program will not be affected.

The request does not apply to other General Arts and Science – University Transfer articulation agreements:

- Ontario College Certificate in General Arts and Science – University Transfer to Bachelor of Arts (Honours) or Bachelor of Science (Honours) - ONCAT #1760; or
- Ontario College Certificate in General Arts and Science – University Transfer to Bachelor of Education – Indigenous - ONCAT # 4480.

Fleming College will make all efforts to ensure current participating students under this Agreement will not be negatively affected by this change. Moreover, the College will immediately remove all references to the Agreement from its promotional materials.

Fleming values the continued collaboration and partnership with Trent University.
