This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which shall become effective as of the Fall 2023 intake at Trent University. These changes will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new agreement is entered in to, whichever occurs first.

The following changes have occurred:

- COMM 201: Communications I has been replaced by COMM 19: Academic Writing and Research I in Fleming College's certificate in Pre-health Sciences to Advanced Diplomas and Degrees. This change will not affect the equivalencies granted in this agreement. Students are allowed to complete either COMM 19 or COMM 201 and qualify for this agreement.

These changes specifically refer to Sections 5.1 of the Agreement.

[TRENT DEGREE AND PROGRAM NAME]: TRANSFER CREDITS

Students graduating from the Pre-health Sciences to Advanced Diplomas and Degrees certificate program with a minimum overall average of 75%, who are eligible, will be granted 3.5 credits toward the successful completion of a 20.0 credit Bachelor of Science (Honours) degree.
