This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which shall become effective as of the Fall 2023 intake at Trent University. These changes will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new agreement is entered in to, whichever occurs first.

The following changes have occurred:

• Aligning transfer credit blocks for all Early Childhood Education Diploma agreements with Fleming College (#4904, #5441 and #5719) to represent the most up-to-date transfer equivalencies.

These changes specifically refer to Section 5 of the Agreement.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (HONOURS): TRANSFER CREDITS

Students graduating from the Early Childhood Education Diploma program with a minimum overall average of 75%, who are eligible, will be granted 7.0 credits toward the successful completion of a 20.0 credit Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree.
