This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which shall become effective as of the Fall 2024 intake at Trent University. These changes will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new agreement is entered in to, whichever occurs first.

The following changes have occurred:

- Changes to requirements in the Policing and Community Well-being program, including:
 - Increased PLCW course requirements;
 - o Reduction in 4000-level PLCW requirements from 1.5 to 1.0 (Honours);
 - Removal of 2000-level PLCW requirements (General only);
 - o Removal of CHYS-COMM 2000H/SOCI 2151H requirement;
 - o Removal of INDG 1001H requirement.

These changes specifically refer to Section 6 of the Agreement.
