This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which became effective as of the Fall 2024 intake at Fleming College. These changes will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new agreement is entered in to, whichever occurs first.

The following changes to the Agreement have occurred:

- Updated transfer credit block to reflect changes in the Early Childhood Education Diploma, including:
 - Replacement of COMM 201 Communications I (45 hours) with COMM 256 Communications I for Community Development Professionals (45 hours);
 - Removal of COMM 202 Communications II (45 hours).
- Updated degree requirement chart to reflect the new transfer credit block.

These changes specifically refer to Sections 5 and 6 of the Agreement.
