

Pathways 101

Pathway: An agreement between two institutions, that authorizes students under taken in specific programs to be credited toward direct entry into advanced standing into a specific program at the receiving institution.

Transfer: The acceptance and recognition of credits by a host institution on the basis of successful completion courses at another educational institution in order to minimize the duplication of learning. *Not known as advanced standing.*

Not Transfer is not the same as a Pathway!

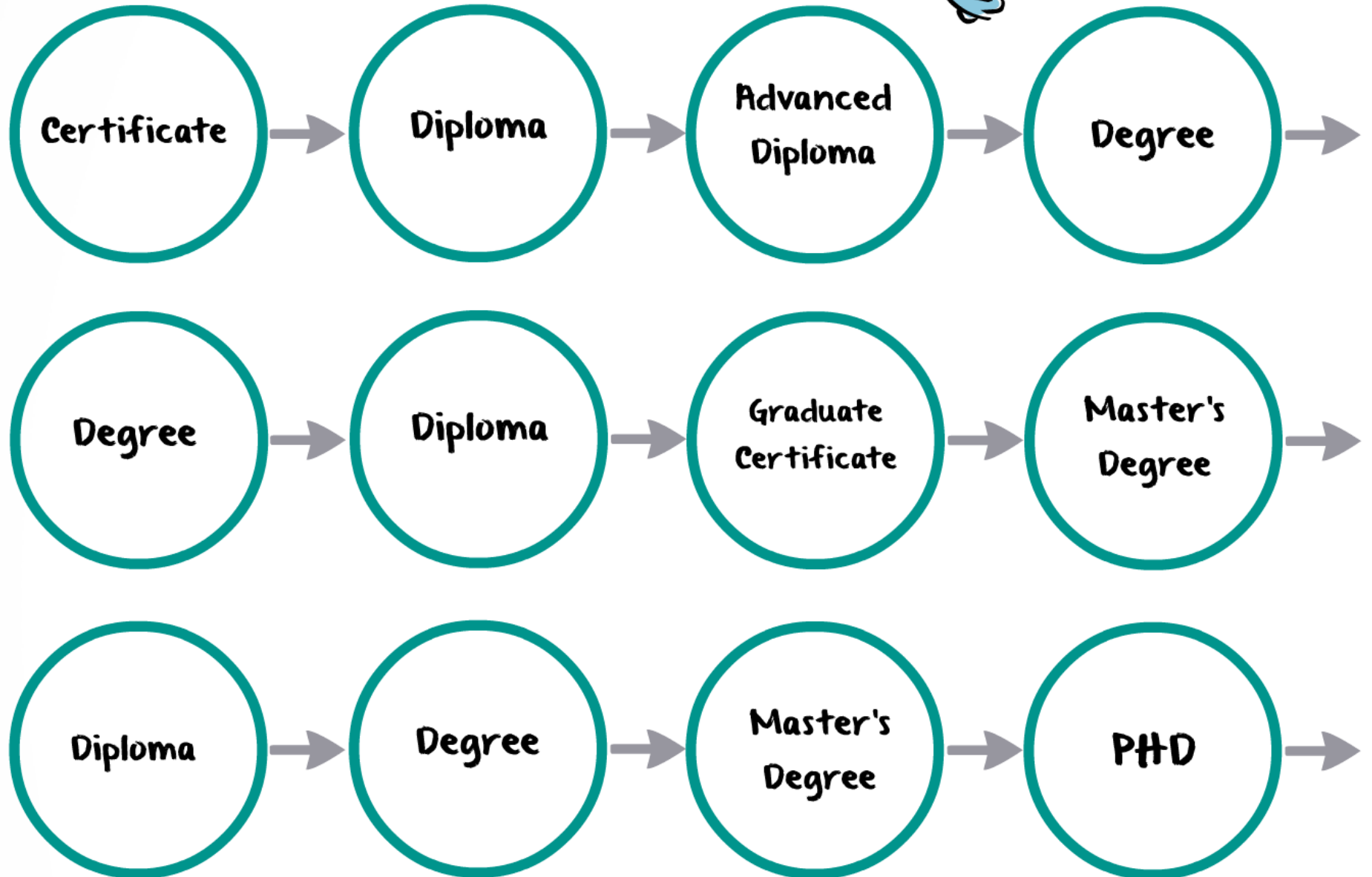
Pathways 101
