This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below and shall become effective as of the September 2018 intake and remain effective until a new agreement is entered into.

Section 5 has been included in this Addendum to account for a typographical error in the original Agreement. Trent University has also implemented the following degree requirement changes. These changes specifically refer to Section 6 of the Agreement.

**BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (HONOURS): TRANSFER CREDITS**

Students graduating from the Fleming College program with a minimum overall average of 75%, who are eligible, will be granted 10.0 credits towards the successful completion of a 20.0 credit Bachelor of Business Administration degree.
