AND

TRENT UNIVERSITY'S BACHELOR OF ARTS (HONOURS)

This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which took effect as of the Fall 2016 and 2017 intakes of the Early Childhood Education Diploma program at Fleming College. These change will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new Agreement is entered into, whichever occurs first.

The following changes have occurred in the Early Childhood Education Diploma program as of the Fall 2016 intake at Fleming College:

- COMM 201 Communications I (45 hours), which receives the equivalent of WRIT 1001H at Trent, was added to the program; and
- COMM 202 Communications II (45 hours), which receives the equivalent of WRIT 2002H at Trent, has replaced COMM 146 Communicating at Work for the Helping Professions (45 hours).
