This Addendum recognizes the changes outlined below, which shall become effective as of the September 2020 intake at Trent University. These changes will remain effective until the above-mentioned Agreement expires or until a new agreement is entered in to, whichever occurs first.

The following changes have been implemented at Trent University:

- The School of Education has adjusted the requirements for the Bachelor of Education – Indigenous program;
- A new course, EDUC-INDG 1030H, has been introduced as a requirement.

These changes specifically refer to Section 6 of the Agreement.
