Transfer Credit Agreement Between

University of Waterloo Honours BA- Recreation and Leisure Studies

and Sir Sandford Fleming College Recreation and Leisure Services

This document serves as an agreement between the Department of Recreation and Leisure Studies, University of Waterloo and Recreation and Leisure Services, Sir Sandford Fleming College. It recognizes that a student who has completed a diploma at Fleming College in Recreation and Leisure Services with a minimum average of 75% will be eligible for up to 5.0 transfer credits at the University of Waterloo towards a 4 year Honours Bachelor of Arts in Recreation and Leisure Studies. This agreement recognizes the high quality of courses that Fleming College students currently take, and the confidence UW's Department of Recreation and Leisure Studies has in considering Fleming College graduates for admission.

Fleming College graduates will be considered in the same applicant pool as internal transfer students and external transfer students, but will be given preferential consideration over all other college Recreation and Leisure Studies programs where transfer credit agreements do NOT exist.

This agreement will be reviewed annually in June in order to update course revisions. Each student's transcript will be assessed individually because of the flexibility in choice of electives available at the college level.
