#### ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

### Purpose:

The purpose of this agreement is to provide students at Fleming College's Haliburton School of the Arts, enrolled in the Diploma in Visual and Creative Arts, the opportunity to transfer into a Bachelor's degree at Emily Carr University of Art + Design.

#### **Terms and Conditions:**

- 1.) Transfer to the Bachelor of Fine Art (Visual Art and General Fine Art majors).
- a) Students who complete the two year Diploma in Visual and Creative Arts at Fleming College with a specialization in one of the following: Artist Blacksmith; Ceramics; Drawing and Painting; Fibre Arts; Glass Blowing; Jewelry Essentials; Photo Arts; Sculpture or Generalist option will be considered for admission to the third year of the BFA in Visual Art or General Fine Art at Emily Carr University.

Students who have completed the Diploma in Visual and Creative Arts at Fleming College with an average of C (2.00) or higher will be considered for admission to year (3) of the Bachelor of Fine Art (Visual Art or General Fine Art majors) on the basis of their academic standing and a portfolio review.

Fleming College students qualifying for admission will receive the following credits on transfer:

2) Transfer to the Bachelor of Fine Art (Animation, Film, Video + Integrated Media and Photography majors); and the Bachelor of Design (Communication Design and Industrial Design majors).

Students who have completed the Diploma in Visual and Creative Arts at Fleming College with an average of C (2.00) or higher will normally be considered for admission to year two (2) of the above noted programs on the basis of their academic standing and a portfolio review. It should be noted that these programs have competitive entry and therefore the portfolio should reflect work that is consistent with the intended major.

3) Credit Assignment and Deficiencies

Based on the Fleming College Diploma (2008), students admitted to the Bachelor of Fine Art (Visual Art and General Fine Art majors) will receive a total of 57 credits on transfer. Students will be deficient 3 credits of first year English (University Transfer). Students should consider making up the first year English deficiencies prior to admission to Emily Carr University.
