

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
BETWEEN
Fleming College
AND
Trent University

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and entered into by and between Fleming College (Fleming) and Trent University (Trent).

A. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this MOU is to outline a pathway for Admission for graduates of Fleming's Preparatory Health Science certificate program to the following Bachelor of Science Programming at Trent. It should be noted that graduates of Fleming's Preparatory Health Certificate program are also eligible for admission to all Bachelor of Arts degree programs at Trent.

B. STATEMENT OF MUTUAL BENEFIT AND INTERESTS:

This admission pathway provides the opportunity for graduates of Fleming's Preparatory Health Science certificate program to be considered for admission into all Bachelor of Arts degree programs and various Bachelor of Science degree programming at Trent as noted in section A of the MOU.

C. TERMS OF AGREEMENT:

1. Trent agrees to consider applications for admission to Trent programming as noted in section A of this MOU for any student who graduates Fleming's Preparatory Health Science certificate program with a minimum 65% overall average (75% for Nursing, 70% for Environmental & Resource Science, Forensic Science and Kinesiology).
2. Students must meet all specific admission and enrollment standards, and requirements for the program and will be accepted subject to program capacity. Obtaining the minimum overall average does not guarantee an offer of admission to the program as many of the programs have pre-determine enrolment caps and acceptance to the programs is highly competitive.
3. Fleming students must apply to their desired programming through the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) and pay the associated fees.
4. Students admitted to Trent from Fleming are not guaranteed transfer credits for advanced standing in the Trent program. Courses completed in the Preparatory Health Science Certificate program at Fleming provide the necessary pre-requisite courses to be considered for admission to the Trent programming noted in section A of this MOU. Student transcripts will be reviewed on an individual basis for transfer credits and applied where applicable.
5. Trent's program faculty will support incoming students by providing them with relevant information related to their program.
6. The Admissions Office at Trent will be responsible for ensuring that eligible Fleming students are offered admission to the Trent program selected as specified in the OUAC application.
7. Fleming and Trent agree to promote the opportunity to eligible students while recruitment representatives at Trent University will be responsible for recruiting students and providing the necessary orientation as students move from one institution to the other.
8. Fleming agrees to notify Trent of any changes to the curriculum in the Preparatory Health Science certificate program to ensure any new courses still meet the necessary prerequisites needed for the Trent programs mentioned in section A.

9. Through communication with program faculty and orientation sessions, students will be advised to consult academic advisors to ensure they are successfully completing all Trent degree requirements.


D. LENGTH OF AGREEMENT

Addendum to Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Fleming College and Trent University

regarding the Admission pathway for the former certificate titled Preparatory Health Science

MOU effective date: September 13, 2016
Addendum effective date: December 16, 2016

1. Effective September 2016 Fleming College renamed the Preparatory Health Science certificate to **Pre-Health Science Pathway to Advanced Diplomas and Degrees**.
2. The new program title will appear on student transcripts effective June 2017 applying to Trent University for admissions consideration. This change does not impact the signed MOU between the parties as no changes to curriculum or course sequencing have occurred since Trent University's review of the program.
3. This addendum will remain in place for the duration of the signed MOU between the parties.
