

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

LAKEHEAD UNIVERSITY

and

FLEMING COLLEGE

This articulation agreement establishes a procedure for admission of qualified students from Fleming College who have successfully completed the Park Operations & Outdoor Recreation (Parks and Forest Recreation) Program into the Honours Bachelor of Outdoor Recreation offered at Lakehead University.

OBJECTIVES OF THE AGREEMENT

1. To provide students from Fleming College who satisfy the criteria described in this agreement the opportunity to obtain admission to the Honours Bachelor of Outdoor Recreation at Lakehead University.
2. To attract students to Fleming College and to Lakehead University.
3. To inform students about educational linkages and opportunities available in the field of outdoor recreation, parks and tourism.
4. To promote an effective partnership between educators at Fleming College and Lakehead University who prepare people for professional careers in the area of outdoor recreation, parks and tourism.

TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT

1. The agreement applies to all graduates of the Park Operations & Outdoor Recreation (Parks and Forest Recreation) Program who graduate with a 75% average.
2. Fleming College and Lakehead University agree to encourage qualified students to enrol by advising and informing students about the benefits of this articulated program.
3. Lakehead University agrees to advance all Park Operations & Outdoor Recreation (Parks and Forest Recreation) program graduates who qualify, 5.5 full credit equivalents including Outdoor Recreation 1010, 1110, 1230, 1510 and 2810, Biology 1130, Humanities 1_10, Geography 1_10, Computer Science 0312, and Science 1_00).
4. Students who qualify must follow the regular course of study prescribed in the Lakehead

University Calendar for the completion of the Honours Bachelor of Outdoor Recreation, and may be eligible for any of the double degree programs offered in conjunction with the HBOR.


5. This agreement will apply to all graduates of the Park Operations & Outdoor Recreation (Parks and Forest Recreation) Program beginning with the date of signing of this agreement.

PERIOD OF AGREEMENT


This articulation agreement will become effective immediately and shall be reviewed every five years. Each institution must inform the other in writing of curriculum changes at the time those changes are being determined.




