

Agreement for a Programming Linkage Between Fleming College and Lakehead University

This document serves to update the original programme links established in May 2001 between Lakehead University's School of Outdoor Recreation, Parks and Tourism and Fleming College's Graduate Studies programme in Ecotourism and Adventure Tourism Management.

Students in the School of Outdoor Recreation, Parks and Tourism who complete the requirements detailed in this agreement and who maintain good academic standing, will receive an Outdoor Recreation, Parks and Tourism degree from Lakehead University and an Ecotourism and Adventure Tourism Management College Graduate certificate from Fleming College.

Qualified School of Outdoor Recreation, Parks and Tourism students will enroll in the Ecotourism and Adventure Tourism Management college graduate studies program at the Haliburton Campus of Fleming College for the **winter term of their fourth year**. Students will be conditionally accepted into Fleming's college graduate certificate programme based on their standing in the HBOR program.

Fleming will recognize advanced standing for the Fall semester of the Ecotourism and Adventure Tourism Management Program. The specific courses from Lakehead that fulfill the Fall semester of the Ecotourism and Adventure Tourism Management Program are attached. Identified gaps in the course content will be dealt with on a case by case basis during the winter semester that students are at Fleming, Haliburton.

Lakehead students who are interested in pursuing this option, will apply to Fleming through the OCAS application procedure in the year preceding their desired registration. In the OCAS application, the student must identify the Ecotourism and Adventure Tourism Management Program (EAM). Fleming College will offer a provisional acceptance and the applicant will be required to submit an official transcript showing completion of the advanced standing courses at the end of the Fall semester of their fourth year.

Students who participate in this option will complete four full years of course work (over nine terms of study) at Lakehead University and complete one term of study at Fleming College (within their last two terms of study). Students will pay applicable fees and tuition at the institution they are attending in any particular term.
