

**Articulation Agreement
between
Sir Sandford Fleming College and Nipissing University**

Purpose:

The purpose of this agreement is to provide graduates of the Fleming College Ontario College Diploma in Visual and Creative Arts, at the Haliburton School of the Arts, the opportunity to transfer into a Bachelor's degree at Nipissing University.

Terms of the Agreement:

Graduates of Fleming College's Visual and Creative Arts diploma who have an overall 70% average (3.0 GPA) will be eligible to receive advance standing into year two of Nipissing University's Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) or Bachelor of Arts (BA) in fine arts or Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Culture and the Arts (to a maximum of 33 credits.)

Nipissing also has an Orientation to Teaching (OTT) option for these programs. OTT is an opportunity offered only at Nipissing. OTT, which considers a set of courses and a non-credit practical experience, that when taken as part of an undergraduate degree, provides preparation for the Bachelor of Education (BEd) consecutive program.

Students who complete a degree with OTT with an overall average of 75% or better calculated on their best 10 full university courses (60 credits) will be guaranteed* a spot in the one year Bachelor of Education Program for the September immediately following the completion of their degree. (*Minimum BEd admission criteria with regard to teachable subjects still apply.)

This agreement is to be reviewed every three years from the date of signing or if there are changes to 25% or more of the curriculum.
