How do I apply to live in residence?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New students may only apply to residence after receiving their Program Acceptance, which will be mailed after February 1, 2018 from the Fleming Admissions Department.</li> <li>• Students may apply for residence online at <a href="http://www.flemingcollege.ca/student-life/residence">www.flemingcollege.ca/student-life/residence</a> starting February 1, 2018 for the Fall 2018/Winter 2019 year.</li> <li>• Students MUST have a Fleming student number in order to apply.</li> <li>• Each year there are more students who apply to live in residence for the September intake than there are rooms.</li> <li>• A lottery will be held <b>after</b> the April 13, 2018 deadline for the September intake.</li> <li>• The Winter 2019 and Summer 2019 application process opens September 17, 2018</li> </ul>
Is there a deadline date to apply?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deadline for applying and paying the \$75.00 Application Processing Fee (non-refundable) is <b>APRIL 13, 2018</b> for the September intake. We strictly adhere to this date.</li> <li>• Please send payment directly to the appropriate residence office at the campus to which you are applying.</li> </ul>
What if I apply after the deadline date?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your application will be waitlisted.</li> </ul>
When will my confirmation acceptance and room assignment be sent to me?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be notified by email at the end of April whether or not they have been offered a room in residence or have been placed on the waitlist.</li> <li>• Students who have been accepted to residence will receive their room assignment information by mid-July.</li> </ul>
How does the waitlist process work?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If your application is waitlisted, you will be provided a waitlist number. You may monitor your progress on the waitlist by visiting <a href="http://www.flemingcollege.ca/student-life/housing">www.flemingcollege.ca/student-life/housing</a>. If a space becomes available, we will contact you. Please be sure to regularly check your email.</li> </ul>
What should I do if I do not receive an acceptance to residence?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Visit Fleming's Off-Campus Housing website <a href="https://flemingcollege.ca/student-life/off-campus-housing">https://flemingcollege.ca/student-life/off-campus-housing</a></li> <li>• For more info email <a href="mailto:och@flemingcollege.ca">och@flemingcollege.ca</a> or call 1-866-353-6464 ext. 1125</li> </ul>
Are there any extra costs?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You will need money for food and other personal items.</li> <li>• If you wish to have telephone line connected in your room, you are responsible for hook up and financial arrangements through Bell Canada (<i>Frost Residence only</i>).</li> <li>• If you wish to have cable in your bedroom, (Common Room is provided free) you are responsible for hook up and financial arrangements through Cogeco.</li> </ul>
Are meal plans available? Do I have to purchase meal plan?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Yes, meal plans are available. Please refer to the Meal Plan FAQs for information: FROST: <a href="https://department.flemingcollege.ca/housing/attachment/1892/download">https://department.flemingcollege.ca/housing/attachment/1892/download</a> SUTHERLAND: <a href="https://department.flemingcollege.ca/housing/attachment/423/download">https://department.flemingcollege.ca/housing/attachment/423/download</a></li> <li>• Meals plans are mandatory for Sutherland Residence students and they are not mandatory for Frost Residence students.</li> </ul>
How close is the residence to the campus?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The residence is approximately a three-minute walk to the campus.</li> </ul>

When is Fall 2017 Move-In?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Residence move-in is Monday, September 3, 2018 on Labour Day weekend.</li> </ul>
What if I have special accommodation needs?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There are rooms designated for students with physical disabilities. If you have a physical disability, please indicate if you have a physical disability when you apply and contact the residence office.</li> </ul>
Where will I store my stuff?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You will need to store everything except your bike in your room. Secured bike storage is located at the residence.</li> </ul>
May I have overnight guests in my room?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Yes, you need to complete an overnight guest form and have your suitemates and a residence staff member sign it. Your guest must carry a guest pass and sleep in your bedroom.</li> <li>Guests are limited to a maximum stay of 72 hours.</li> </ul>
May I bring a pet into residence?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No, you may not bring any pets into residence with the exception of non-dangerous fish in an aquarium no larger than 30 litres.</li> </ul>
Do I have to share a bedroom?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No, all bedrooms are single occupancy and you share the kitchen, common room and two bathrooms with up to five other students.</li> </ul>
What is provided in a residence room?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All residence rooms are carpeted and include curtains, bed, desk with drawer unit, chair, dresser, closet and overhead light. All residence beds are twin size and you will need to supply sheets, pillows, pillowcases, blankets and comforters.</li> <li>A microwave, fridge, and stove are provided in every kitchen.</li> <li>The common room and eating area are completely furnished.</li> <li>Your residence fees include cable in all the common rooms and wireless internet.</li> <li>VOIP phone for local calls only, calling cards required for long distance (<i>Sutherland Residence Village only</i>).</li> </ul>
What should I bring from home?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You may bring a small fridge or freezer for your room.</li> <li>No extra furniture is allowed without prior approval from the Residence Manager.</li> </ul>
What are Senior Resident Assistants (SRAs) and Resident Assistants (RAs)?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SRAs and RAs are residence student staff that live with students on each floor. They are an excellent resource for services on and off campus. As well they will answer your questions, plan activities, and ensure that the privileges of residence life are enjoyed.</li> </ul>
How can I get involved in Residence Leadership?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There are many activities that are run by your peers in residence. Students should inquire at the residence office or speak with your Resident Assistant on your floor to find out about the many activities offered.</li> </ul>
May I select my own suitemates?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When you apply online, you may select up to two preferred suitemates but the request must be mutual.</li> </ul>
