

Associate Director, Labour Relations

The incumbent will assist in the collective bargaining process and represent Council on a variety of provincial joint union/management committees.

Responsibilities:

- Provides technical advice, consultative services, on-going support and assistance to all levels of college HR staff and legal counsel on a variety of labour relations functions: collective agreement interpretation, legislation, job evaluation and arbitrations.
- Establishes, maintains and fosters a solid working relationship with union representatives.
- Lead/assist provincial joint committees
- Prepare and conduct training on assorted labour relations matters
- Lead/assist in negotiating collective agreements including identification of issues, research, emerging trends.
- Prepare and conduct training on assorted labour relations matters

Requirements:

- A degree/diploma together with completion of a Certified HR professional designation (CHRP) and/or a higher credential in a relevant field (e.g. Human Resources, Industrial Relations, Law), or an acceptable equivalent combination of education and experience.
- At least 7+ years of experience in labour relations
- Highly developed communication skills (verbal and written) and tact are essential to work with diverse client base
- Excellent organizational, analytical and decision making skills
- Strong negotiating skills and sense of initiative along with solid judgement
- Able to work independently as well as function as part of an integrated team
