Our offer does this through proposals that offer certainty and provide enhancements with respect to:

- Faculty workloads
- Partial-load enhancements
- Advancing Truth and Reconciliation

# **Employer Final Offer Includes:**

## **Faculty Workload**

- Joint committee
- Most extensive review since 2009
- Neutral led to ensure work is completed

#### **Partial-Load Enhancements**

- Improves priority and accrual of service
- Maintains priority if course code/name changes
- Already includes bridging of benefits

### **Advancing Truth and Reconciliation**

- Process to be Indigenous developed and driven by design.
- Offer does not pre-determine process or resolution mechanisms.
- Seeks meaningful engagement of Indigenous communities.



As I mentioned to you in my first note – the focus of our bargaining team has been on tabling an agreement that provides you with certainty in uncertain times.

That is why our first approach to OPSEU in February 2021 was to extend the current collective agreement – to get us through the rest of COVID and the constraints placed on us all by Bill 124.

While it's unfortunate that OPSEU decided not to extend the agreement, we have worked hard since then to put forward proposals which reasonably address the areas of concern that have been raised by the union bargaining team.

Next week, we'll continue sharing with you how management's offer will bring certainty on the issues that matter to you.

We want to **thank you** for your consideration of our offer and for everything you do to put students first.



We sincerely hope that you will <u>support CEC's final offer</u> so that we can bring the certainty you, students, and the colleges deserve in these uncertain times.
