# **Administrative Staff Benefit Changes**

The Human Resources Steering Committee of CEC accepted the recommendation of the Governors' Review Committee to provide benefit enhancements for Administrative Staff Employees. As a result, the following enhancements to your benefit plan will become effective **February 1**, **2024**.

### **Paramedical Services**

- The combined paramedical annual maximum will increase from \$3,900 to \$4,750.
- The paramedical services reimbursement level will increase from 85% to 90%.

## **Medical Cannabis**

Medical Cannabis will be added to the Plan, subject to a \$4,000 annual maximum per individual, per benefit year (January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>).

Cannabis for medical treatment must be prescribed by a licensed physician, and is subject to prior authorization from Sun Life. The information you and your doctor provide on the *Prior Approval Form for Medical Cannabis* must meet the clinical criteria, including symptoms, for conditions approved by Sun Life. If you submit a claim for Medical Cannabis and have not been pre-approved, your claim will be declined. Medical Cannabis must be obtained from a Health Canada approved producer. To obtain the *Prior Approval Form for Medical Cannabis*, you can call Sun Life's Customer Care Center at 1-800-361-6212.

### **Dental Care**

- The major restorative coverage (Type E services) annual maximum will increase from \$2,500 to \$4,000.
- Dental implants will be added as an eligible service under the major restorative coverage (Type E services).
- This coverage will only apply to a tooth that was extracted or lost on or after February 1, 2024.
