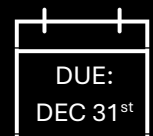

The Learning Design and Support (LDS) Team offers a variety of professional learning opportunities for faculty members.

Regular Programming:

The **New Faculty Experience** is designed to support new full-time faculty members. This program emphasizes faculty practicing high-impact instructional skills in a low-stakes, collegial environment, to receive constructive feedback throughout their first year of full-time faculty employment with Fleming College.



The online **Contract Faculty Experience** is designed to support new contract faculty members to become familiar with their roles and responsibilities at Fleming College as well as the resources available to support the success of all students.

The **Faculty Development Process** is an opportunity for full-time, post-probation faculty members to engage in reflective practice and explore evidence-based practices to improve student learning in their own classrooms.

Workshops and Sessions:

Teaching and Learning Kick-Off Sessions support new contract faculty members with teaching tips for the first days and weeks of class.

Teaching and Learning Days happen during Reading Weeks and Intersession periods and focus on relevant teaching and learning topics.

Workshops On-Demand: Chairs, Deans, and faculty teams are invited to request a session on a specific topic.
