The theme this year is




Asking anyone and everyone to come out, decorate our float and join in the parade.

Purpose:

In an effort to increase the activity and wellness of staff and the visibility of diversity at Fleming we are proposing that walking routes be marked using the rainbow markers with arrows.

This would serve the following purposes:

- increase staff awareness of the importance of walking on breaks
- help Fleming celebrate diversity by using the rainbow colours as route markers
- increase the likelihood of staff walking on breaks for those unfamiliar with the walking routes
- takes approximate 15 minutes to complete
- 2 routes. One that includes stairs and a second route that showcases inclusion with a similar route that utilizes elevators for those unable to use the stairs
 Staff and students can walk anytime or meet in the main lobby at 10:30 and/or 2:30 to walk with a group.
