Detailed Narrative:

As the Province lifts public health measures and guidance for Covid-19, employers should have appropriate measures and procedures in place to protect workers which address the current hazards in the workplace based on the specific risks which are present.

Measures that may assist in the prevention of the spread of infectious disease include:

- recognizing the signs and symptoms of respiratory illness and take appropriate action
- take appropriate precautions to protect workers from symptomatic individuals
- hand hygiene and sanitation practices
- other relevant workplace specific controls

Under the OHSA, employers and supervisors must take every precaution reasonable in the circumstance for the protection of workers. Workers are required to wear any personal protective equipment required by their employer and to report any hazards they observe.

Employers and workers should engage the internal responsibility system to continue to look at ways of decreasing the risk of exposure. As a reminder, worker health and safety representatives and Joint Health and Safety Committees (JHSCs) have the power to make recommendations to employers with respect to health and safety in the workplace.

Based on a risk assessment and consultation with the JHSC or worker health and safety representatives, the employer may choose to voluntarily maintain COVID precautions that exceed the minimum requirements of the Plan to Safely Reopen Ontario.

This visit was conducted in response to a notice of occupational illness received by the MLTSD. One worker tested positive for COVID-19 in March 2022. It was discussed that it could have possibly been contracted while conducting training for students at a facility located at 36 Industrial Dr., Norwood ON. The worker has since returned to work.

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An electronic copy of the Notice of Occupational Illness was received from the employer.

The workplace parties indicated they have measures and procedures in place addressing the following:

Information & Instruction to Workers

Workers have been provided with information and instruction on COVID-19 including signs and symptoms, hand hygiene, PPE, physical distancing and sanitation. The workplace has program specific COVID-19 safety plans. Any updates are communicated to workers. There is also COVID-19 specific training for students.

Joint Health and Safety Committee (JHSC) /Health and Safety Rep Involvement: COVID-19 and any changes to measures and procedures are discussed at JHSC meetings.

Social/Physical Distancing Measures in Place:

The employer strongly suggests to workers that they maintain at least 2m of space between themselves and others. Workers generally drive their own vehicles to off-site training/excursions.

Screening Measures:

Passive screening occurs at the workplace. Workers know that they are not to attend the workplace if they have any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. Active screening was being conducted at the time of the worker testing positive.

Cleaning and Disinfecting/Hand Hygiene:

Soap and hand sanitizer is readily available for workers.

Personal Protective Equipment:

The employer recommends that workers wear masks. Workers have access to different types of masks (KN95, N95 etc.). Workers were still required to wear masks at the time that the worker tested positive.

No further action is required at this time by MLTSD
