

Application for “Designation” of Two Construction Projects as Separate Projects

A project owner (or the owner’s agent) can apply to the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development to have a single project split into two or more different projects. If approved, each project must be clearly separated by time or location and will have its own constructor who is responsible for onsite workers’ health and safety. The project owner (or the owner’s agent) must make this request.

Fleming College as the “Owner” will keep the two separate general contractors as separate “Constructors”. Each “Constructor” will file a separate Notice of Project (NOP) and attach with the NOP, a detailed description and outline of geographic location. Each “Constructor” will provide details of separation by time and/or space and carefully maintain control and direction over each project.

Designations under section 4 of Ontario Regulation 213/91 are discretionary. Applicants must provide sufficient details to confirm that workers on one project will not be endangered by the construction activities on adjacent project(s). Applicants should provide detailed information and descriptions and, where appropriate, diagrams (site plan(s) and/or floor plan(s)) in support of the request, including information and supporting documents that demonstrate how the health and safety of workers will be achieved if the designation is approved.
