

# What to expect when reporting sexual assault/violence

## Start

Complete online form or talk to any College employee. **You choose** which reporting option works best for you.  
\*College employees are required to report an incident – will be informal and anonymous\*

FYI: The person you are making a report about has a right to know and to defend themselves

Informal Report:  
Anonymous

The College is unlikely to have enough information to investigate or sanction

The College may use this information to respond without involving you

If you told an employee (not the online form), they may check in with you again. Security may see a public safety threat and ask if you would like to come forward with more information. You have the option, and right to say no

Support and accommodations are always available regardless of your reporting choice.

Accommodations are available through your teacher or a counsellor can work out your accommodations confidentially on your behalf

Formal College Report  
Not Anonymous

Confirmation that report has been received within 3 days

Assigned case manager will contact you to arrange an interview

Investigation takes place within 15 business days – sometimes sooner

Reporter will be notified of the results of the investigation

The reporter is able to appeal the decision.
